The year's early months were characterized by large demonstrations and violent clashes between protesters and government forces that resulted in nearly 4,000 arrests and 43 deaths, including

both supporters and opponents of the government

A castrum was the fortified base of a Roman legion, a detachment thereof, or of auxiliary units, providing secure locations for training, administration, and defense. The army used a variety of fortified positions, both in size and

function, ranging from temporary marching camps (*castra aestiva*) to large, permanent fortresses (*castra stativa*) that housed entire legions. They were typically designed with a standardized layout, including a rectangular plan, defensive walls, gates, and internal streets arranged in a grid pattern, reflecting Roman military discipline and engineering expertise. Permanent *castra* often became the foundations for towns and cities across the Roman Empire, many of which still bear traces of their Roman origins in their modern layouts and names.
