Competition and Consumer Act 2010 The aim of this part of the act is to encourage competition in upstream The Competition and Consumer Act 2010 (CCA) is an Act of the Parliament of Australia. It is administered by the Australian Competition & Consumer Commission (ACCC) and also gives some rights for private action. significance. Schedule 2 of the CCA sets out the Australian Consumer Law (ACL). Prior to 1 January 2011, it was known as the Trade Practices Act 1974 (TPA). The Federal Court of Australia has the jurisdiction to determine private and public complaints made in regard to contraventions of the Act. The Act is the legislative vehicle for competition law in Australia, and seeks to promote competition, fair trading as well as providing protection for consumers. For example, it covers access to electricity grids or natural gas pipelines c72f779d2e

Demand response Demand response, a type of energy demand management, seeks to. Until the 21st century decrease in the cost of pumped storage and batteries, electric energy could not be easily stored, so utilities have traditionally matched demand and supply by throttling the production rate of their power plants, taking generating units on or off line, or importing power from other utilities. There are limits to what can be achieved on the supply side, because some generating units can take a long time to come up to full power, some units may be very expensive to operate, and demand can at times be greater than the capacity of all the available power plants put together. blackout of 2003 Relative cost of electricity generated by different sources Energy Reduction Assets "People will be paid to use less electricity on Monday" Demand response is a change in the power consumption of an electric utility customer to better match the demand for power with the supply c72f779d2e

Energy policy of the United Kingdom The United Kingdom has had success in this, though energy intensity remains high. Areas of focus for energy policy by the UK government have changed since the Electricity Act 1989 and the Gas Act 1986. The energy policy of the United Kingdom refers to the United Kingdom's efforts towards reducing energy intensity, reducing energy poverty, and maintaining energy supply reliability. There is an ambitious goal to reduce carbon dioxide emissions in future years, but it is unclear whether the programmes in place are sufficient to achieve this objective. The EEG first came into force on 1 April 2000 and has been modified several times since. The original legislation guaranteed a grid connection, preferential dispatch, and a government-set feed-in tariff for 20 years, dependent on the technology and size of project. The scheme was funded by a surcharge on electricity consumers, with electricity-intensive manufacturers and the railways later being required to contribute as little as 0.05 ¢/kWh... c72f779d2e
