Within DFS and DOS, I further distinguish "traditional" and object-oriented approaches. The last chapter is added for the sake of completeness. The survey which follows distinguishes between DFS approaches in Chapters 2-3, and DOS approaches in Chapters 4-5. very brief descriptions of other related systems. Chapter 7 contains a table of comparison. These systems are of minor interest or do not provide transparency at all.
