Certification S. It is the formal attestation or confirmation of certain characteristics of an object, person, or organization. This confirmation is often, but not always, provided by some form of external review, education, assessment, or audit. Accreditation is a specific organization's process of certification. grouped into exam-based and education-based. According to the U. For example Certification is part of testing, inspection and certification and the provision by an independent body of written assurance (a certificate) that the product, service or system in question meets specific requirements. For exam-based certifications the candidate must pass an exam, which can also be learned by self-study. National Council on Measurement in Education, a certification test is a credentialing test used to determine whether individuals are knowledgeable enough in a given occupational area to be labeled "competent to practice" in that area c672a481ba

LLQP Once the certification exam is completed, and criminal records checks are submitted, applicants may apply to their provincial insurance council to write the licensing exam. The LLQP exam certificate is valid in all provinces and territories except Quebec. Once the provincial exam is completed and passed, the applicant may complete the requirements to apply for a licence to sell life insurance, accident and sickness products, and life insurance related investment products like Segregated funds and annuities. choice exam, with a heavy orientation towards case-study style multiple choice questions. Students would be given three hours to complete this exam. This LLQP (Life Licence Qualification Program) is part of the Canadian licensing regime for life insurance sales people.
