The terms refer to various services rendered to the crown in lieu of payment in coin. The services could usually be commuted to a monetary payment: in Hertfordshire avera could be commuted for fourpence. Avera is connected with carrying items by horse, or possibly ploughing or both. various mammalian cell types, plants, and bacteria. The process of inward-rectification was discovered by Bernard Katz in skeletal muscle cells in 1949, and Denis Noble in cardiac muscle cells in 1960s. IRK channels possess a pore domain, homologous to that of voltage-gated ion channels, and flanking transmembrane segments (TMSs). In terms of function, these proteins transport potassium (K⁺), with a greater tendency for K⁺ uptake than K⁺ export. The malfunction of the channels has been implicated in several diseases. They may exist in the membrane as homo- or heterooligomers and each monomer possesses between 2 and 4 TMSs d7feb44c77

For direct inward dialing service, the telephone company provides one or more trunk lines to the customer for connection to the customer's PBX, and allocates a range of telephone numbers to the customer. Calls to such numbers are forwarded to the customer's PBX via the trunks.
