Three-age system In the 1833 edition of *Principles* The three-age system is the periodization of human prehistory (with some overlap into the historical periods in a few regions) into three time-periods: the Stone Age, the Bronze Age, and the Iron Age, although the concept may also refer to other tripartite divisions of historic time periods. Haeckel, however, was relying heavily on Charles Lyell, well as an Upper and Lower Diluvial (his term for the Pleistocene). The Copper, Bronze, and Iron Ages are also known collectively as the Metal Ages. In some periodizations, a fourth Copper Age is added as between the Stone Age and Bronze Age bcc1020b76
