In particular, the electrical contact resistance (ECR) of stainless steel Stainless steel, also known as inox (an abbreviation of the French term inoxidable, meaning non-oxidizable), corrosion-resistant steel (CRES), or rustless steel, is an iron-based alloy that contains chromium, making it resistant to rust and corrosion. Stainless steel's resistance to corrosion comes from its chromium content of 11% or more, which forms a passive film that protects the material and can self-heal when exposed to oxygen. It can be further alloyed with elements like molybdenum, carbon, nickel and nitrogen to enhance specific properties for various applications

Morse code Friedrich Gerke was another substantial developer; he simplified Vail's code to produce the code adopted in Europe, and most of the alphabetic part of the current international (ITU) "Morse" is copied from Gerke's revision. Morse code is named after Samuel Morse, one of several developers of the code system. Morse's preliminary proposal for a telegraph code was replaced by an alphabet-based code developed by Alfred Vail, the engineer working with Morse; it was Vail's version that was used for commercial telegraphy in North America. The simple "on or off" nature of its Morse code is a telecommunications method which encodes text characters as standardized sequences of two different signal durations, called dots and dashes, or dits and dahs. the American physicist Joseph Henry, and mechanical engineer Alfred Vail developed an electrical telegraph system
