Miss Bud, Edwin Drood's fiancée, has also caught the eye of the high-spirited and hot-tempered Neville Landless. Landless and Edwin Drood take an instant dislike to each other. John Forster (biographer) He was best known for publishing *The Life of Charles Dickens* (1872), which was the first biography published of Charles
