Saturation diving The ratio of productive working time at depth to unproductive decompression time is thereby increased, and the health risk to the diver incurred by decompression is minimised. Unlike other ambient pressure diving, the saturation diver is only exposed to external ambient pressure while at diving depth. The bell Saturation diving is an ambient pressure diving technique which allows a diver to remain at working depth for extended periods during which the body tissues become saturated with metabolically inert gas from the breathing gas mixture. The bell hangs from a cable attached to the top. The diver undergoes a single decompression to surface pressure at the end of the exposure of several days to weeks duration. As the bell is lowered, the fairleads guide it down the clump weight cables to the workplace. Once saturated, the time required for decompression to surface pressure will not increase with longer exposure
