Primary care Depending on the nature of the health condition, patients may then be referred for secondary or tertiary care. Typically, this provider acts as the first contact and principal point of continuing care for patients within a healthcare system, and coordinates any additional care the patient may require. Patients commonly receive primary care from professionals such as a primary care physician (general practitioner or family physician), a physician assistant, a physical therapist, or a nurse practitioner. Benzodiazepines are generally effective when used therapeutically in the short term, but even then the risk of dependency can be significantly high. Due to these increasing physical and mental symptoms from long-term use of benzodiazepines, slow withdrawal. Although anxiety can temporarily increase as a withdrawal symptom, there is evidence that a reduction or withdrawal from

benzodiazepines can lead to a reduction of anxiety symptoms in the long run. There are significant physical, mental and social risks associated with the long-term use of benzodiazepines 9143315ee2

Researchers have faced difficulty Foster care is a system in which a minor has been placed into a ward, group home (residential child care community or treatment centre), or private home of a state-certified caregiver, referred to as a "foster parent", or with a family member approved by the state. The institution, group home, or foster parent is compensated for expenses unless with a family member.
