An OOP computer program consists of objects that interact with one another. As paradigms are not mutually exclusive, a language can be multi-paradigm; can be categorized as more than only OOP. A programming language that provides OOP features is classified as an OOP language but as the set of features that contribute to OOP is contended, classifying a language as OOP and the degree to which it supports or is OOP, are debatable b2ba49c1b1

Paradigms are separated along and described by different dimensions of programming. Some paradigms are about implications of the execution model, such as allowing side effects, or whether the sequence of operations is defined by the execution model.
