Unlike other academic subjects, physical education is distinctive because it engages students across the psychomotor, cognitive, affective, social, and cultural domains of learning. Physical education generally focuses on developing physical fitness, motor skills, health awareness, and social interaction through activities such as sports, exercise, and movement education. progress with teacher feedback. While curricula vary by country, PE generally aims to promote lifelong physical activity and well-being. It is often referred to as Phys. Physical education content differs internationally, as physical activities

It follows the Scout method of informal education with an emphasis on practical outdoor activities, including camping, woodcraft, aquatics, hiking, backpacking and sports. A widely recognized movement characteristic is the Scout uniform, by intent hiding all differences of social standing and encouraging equality, with neckerchief (known as a scarf in some countries) and (originally) a campaign hat or comparable headwear. Distinctive insignia include the fleur-de-lis as well as merit badges or patches. In many countries, girl only organizations, whose members are often called Guides instead of Scouts, use a trefoil insignia instead of the fleur-de-lis. In October 2023, Teachers College announced it would be closing the Reading and Writing Project and replacing it with a new program, based on new research and criticism received about the program in recent years. Calkins is not the director of the new project, which will be managed by the Advancing Literacy unit. Starting in the 2023–2024 school year, the pilot course expanded to approximately 800 schools. The course launched worldwide beginning in August 2024. In some countries, teaching young people of school age may be carried out in an informal setting, such as within the family (homeschooling), rather than in a formal setting such as a school or college. Homeschooling during the COVID-19 pandemic 'Pandemic pod' is the fashionable term used to describe one of these arrangements where all group members agree to participate under well-defined and strictly enforced health rules. The requirements placed on parents to fill in the gaps as teachers aids and support There was a resurgence of homeschooling during the COVID-19 pandemic to help students return to school. The first usually involves hired professionals to teach a small group of kids (similar to one-room schoolhouses). Both are largely available only to the well-off, as costs in time and money are high. and their teachers, or peers, has decreased student's overall motivation. Innovative parents sought to create solutions to their individual dilemmas by organizing local groups. The second is a parent-organized co-operative where families take turns educating and minding their kids during the week. These variations of homeschooling include micro schools and educational family co-ops
