When business analysts work on their own documents, software Specification by example (SBE) is a collaborative approach to defining requirements and business-oriented functional tests for software products based on capturing and illustrating requirements using realistic examples instead of abstract statements. by example is creating a single source of truth about required changes from all perspectives. This approach is particularly successful for managing requirements and functional tests on large-scale projects of significant domain and organisational complexity d5672af415
