Yet, in spite of these advances, practicing clinicians are still frequently at a loss in moving from the characteristics of the disturbed child before them to the final assignment of a psychiatric diagnosis. Furthermore, a great deal of research on methodology in child assessment procedures has emerged recently. The focus of this book is to outline the various methods of viewing and categorizing the wide range childhood psychopathology, with special emphasis on the end product of making a differential diagnosis. Understandably, this approach was controversial, and dissatisfaction with it led to the more recent knowledge that adult and child problems
