Free jazz Europeans tend to favor the term "free improvisation". harmonic vocabulary. Musicians during this period believed that the bebop and modal jazz that had been played before them was too limiting, and became preoccupied with creating something new. Others have used "modern jazz", "creative music", and "art music". The term "free jazz" was drawn from the 1960 Ornette Coleman recording Free Jazz: A Collective Improvisation. Key to this transformation Free jazz, or free form in the early to mid-1970s, is a style of avant-garde jazz or an experimental approach to jazz improvisation that developed in the late 1950s and early 1960s, when musicians attempted to change or break down jazz conventions, such as regular tempos, tones, and chord changes. But the harmonic freedom of these early releases would lead to his transition into free jazz during the early 1960s fedaa788dc
