Symptoms develop gradually and typically begin during young adulthood and rarely resolve. It was developed by psychoanalyst Aaron Beck in the 1950's. Differential diagnosis is problematic since several other neurodevelopmental disorders, including autism spectrum disorder, language disorder, and attention deficit hyperactivity disorder, also have signs and symptoms similar to childhood-onset schizophrenia. Mental status examination There are some minor variations in the subdivision of the MSE and the sequence and names of MSE domains. It is a structured way of observing and describing a

patient's psychological functioning at a given point in time, under the domains of appearance, attitude, behavior, mood and affect, speech, thought process, thought content, perception, cognition, insight, and judgment. Speech production inhibit the development of fluency. Fluency involves constructing coherent utterances and stretches of speech, to respond and to speak without undue hesitation
Speech production is the process by which thoughts are translated into speech. Speech production is not the same as language production since language can also be produced manually by signs. Speech production can be spontaneous such as when a person creates the words of a conversation, reactive such as when they name a picture or read aloud a written word, or imitative, such as in speech repetition. This includes the selection of words, the organization of relevant grammatical forms, and then the articulation of the resulting sounds by the motor system using the vocal apparatus 8475b8981f

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
