Reading comprehension Reading comprehension relies on two abilities that are connected to each other: word reading and language comprehension. Reading comprehension Reading comprehension is the ability to process written text, understand its meaning, and to integrate with what the reader already knows. Reading comprehension is beyond basic literacy alone, which is the ability to decipher characters and words at all. In education it is measured in standardized tests that report which percentile a reader's ability falls. Reading comprehension occurs on a gradient or spectrum, rather than being yes/no (all-or-nothing). The opposite of reading comprehension is called functional illiteracy. Reading comprehension is the ability to process written text, understand its meaning, and to integrate with what the reader already knows. Comprehension specifically is a "creative, multifaceted process" that is dependent upon four language skills: phonology, syntax, semantics, and pragmatics f6f1d2e6b7

The ability to interpret language Auditory verbal agnosia (AVA), also known as pure word deafness, is the inability to comprehend speech. Individuals with this disorder lose the ability to understand language, repeat words, and write from dictation. The maintenance of the ability to process non-speech auditory information, including music, also remains relatively more intact than spoken language comprehension. Sometimes. Individuals who exhibit pure word deafness are also still able to recognize non-verbal sounds. Some patients with AVA describe hearing spoken language as meaningless noise, often as though the person speaking was doing so in a foreign language. The ability to interpret language via lip reading, hand gestures, and context clues is preserved as well f6f1d2e6b7

f6f1d2e6b7 The original WAIS (Form I) was published in February 1955 by David Wechsler, Chief Psychologist at Bellevue Hospital (1932–1967) in NYC, as a revision of the Wechsler–Bellevue Intelligence Scale released in 1939. It is currently in its fifth edition (WAIS-5), released in 2024 by Pearson. It is the most widely used IQ test, for both adults and older adolescents, in the world. f6f1d2e6b7

Characteristic features of dyslexia are difficulties in phonological awareness, verbal memory and verbal processing A reading disability is a condition in which a person displays difficulty reading.
